- Provide outreach to families, including immigrants and refugees, in need of transition information/resources for target population
- Develop leadership training for parents/caregivers
- Create parent/caregivers advisory groups
- Work with Young Adult Navigators to provide comprehensive family support
- Assist with development of an Online Resource Center
- Report to Youth-in-Transition Leadership Team
